

Description of the Issue

You may observe that the **Job Costing Work In Progress** report displays a WIP Balance for a completed Job Card as can be seen below.


One may expect that all completed job cards should have zero WIP Balances but there are instances where this is not observed.



In this case the Job Card consisted of Financial Lines and the user made use fo the Make Inventory Item to complete the job card.


To explain further, consider the following steps on how to recreate this matter:

Capture and process a new Job Card as below. When done, click the Save, Process
 Close button.




2. Process a new GRV as below. Notice the transactional line is linked to the JOB.




3. Open and inspect the Job Card. Notice the new line as coming from the above GRV has been added.




4. Process a new Return to Supplier as below. Notice in this case the Price below is different than the GRV's cost price above.




5. Open and inspect the Job Card. Notice the second line also added below.




6. On the Job Costing grid, right click on the JOB and select the Make Inventory Item.



7. Capture and process the screen as below.



8. Select the **Yes** button below. This is a new feature added in Evolution version 10.1 where the user is warned if there are any outstanding WIP amounts: The total costs added is not equal to the total cost removed from the same job. See further below more details.

9. If you now print the Job Costing Work In Progress report for this job, you'll notice the WIP Balance value as indicated below.

Solution / Details

Please note the following reason for the above displayed WIP Balance:

- Regardless if
 - o linking a GRV and RTS to the job card, or
 - o if manually capturing stock items or financial lines on the job card, or
 - o using the **Make Inventory Item** feature and then
 - o manually closing and processing the Job Card that way,
- If the line **adding** a cost to the job card (e.g., the GRV linked to the job card) is different than the second line **removing** cost from the same job card,
- then the Job Card will have an outstanding WIP Balance.

This means, in this case the Job Card WIP report balance is acceptable, it works as per designed and is not due to a software bug.

Also, as mentioned in step 8 above, the user is warned that the job card has an outstanding balance (The total costs added is not equal to the total cost removed from the same job), if working in Evolution version 10.1 and higher.
